Four improbable teachers playing instruments for the first complete, accelerated course to obtain the ideal audience diploma: this is the game we play together with the Bandaradàn, a little gypsy orchestra with halting rhythms. In the hands of these characters as they juggle with musical staves, the audience learns to dance, to applaud and to sing, in a cleverly conducted total interaction, always poised **between music and theatre**. Tightrope-walking on dotted notes, the Bandaradàn move around freely, get the street on their side and offer music without frontiers, bringing together **Balkan rhythms, Kletzmer traditions and pieces with a circus flavour**; they reinvent them in a decidedly unusual style interspersed with **entertaining gags** and delivered with an extraordinary ability to involve the audience present. It's music for your eyes.



Intent on giving pleasure to the ear, the **Bandaradàn** have the common desire to play freely, acoustically and “anywhere”. After playing as buskers on the Ramblas in Barcelona, the proto-band established the essential lines of its work and opted for an unusual repertoire inspired by Kletzmer, Balkan and circus music. Their street shows blend mime and sound, inspired by the current *musicomica* of “r-umorismo”, devised at the beginning of the Seventies by the Argentine group Les Luthiers and then developed by famous groups such as the Banda Osiris (Italy), the Cosmic Sausages (Great Britain) and the !Mahw (Germany). Habitual guests of the most important busking and festival events in Italy and abroad, they received the **Premio della Regione Piemonte** in 2004 for best street music group in the region. Their natural habitat is on the road, but they are also happy to perform in the big top, in theatres, clubs, cellars and at weddings.
