Our organisation	<i>Śłupsk is less than 100 thousand citizen and is situated in northern part of Poland, near the coast of Baltic sea. It is third largest city in Pomeranian voivodeship and a capital of its subregion by being substantial center of economic and cultural life in society and by nearby coastal tourism. Citizens of Śłupsk, as with other similar cities, are rapidly ageing population. People of post productive age represent over 26% of the overall. Strategy addressing societal challenges conducted in 2019 showed that those people could be threatened with social exclusion and following this need The City has established The Office of Health and Social Affairs which is responsible for elders policy within the city. Right now their main job focuses around implementing Strategy mentioned before. Along with City's institutions, NGOs, citizens and other stakeholders the office runs the social projects, workshops and initiatives to make our city more friendly and caring about its elder citizens and their carers and other residents of our compact city.</i>
