In 1993, Peter Accornero was approached by the founder of Piemonteis Nel Mondo, Sig. Michele Colombino, with the idea of beginning a local chapter in Brisbane.

Mr. Accornero informed the local Piemonteis community of the proposal

and found that there was positive interest, particularly from Tessa Morbelli and Rosanna Boccalatte who became active in the possible formation of a Brisbane/Queensland Chapter.

Interest in the proposed Chapter continued to increase and in 1994, a representative group from Conzano arrived in Brisbane to assist in the development of establishing an Association.

They were welcomed by Leo Lenti, Elvira Guastino, Tessa Morbelli and Rosanna Boccalatte.

During the evening's festivities at the Italo Australian Centre it became very apparent that a "Famiglia Piemonteis" would be formed.



On 31st August 1995, a meeting was held at the Italo Australian Centre, Newmarket with 43 people in attendance, resulting in the election of a steering committee.

The Piemonteis Association of Qld. Inc. was born.


