Targeted analysis



Focus: specific policy processes led by macroregional /national/ regional/ local stakeholders of the ESPON Programme area and **fitting the specific TAP**

Types:

- fast-track targeted analyses (short-length and/or with reduced territorial focus);
- targeted analyses (traditional and foresight-driven);
- enhanced targeted analyses including further developed European territorial evidence and transferability assessment;
- case studies, both spin-off and on-demand; territorial reports (TAP-related at various territorial levels: country, local, FUAs...)

Methodology: traditional or foresight driven, may contain new European territorial evidence

Expected results: It translates European territorial evidence to the particular policy context in the development of all kinds of territories (macroregions, regions, cities, FUAs...)

Stakeholders' involvement: collaboration with national/regional/local stakeholders to define policy questions and/or development scenarios, select case studies and embed the outcomes in policy processes

Results uptake

Selection criteria

- The project shall aim to collect and deliver new territorial evidence aligned to a specific TAP theme and context, and also perform a territorial analysis (use of analytical results in policy making).
- It shall bring a wider European perspective to the territories of the stakeholders (presence of European perspective).
- It shall demonstrate a distinct territorial context and address the specific policy opportunities and challenges in the territories of the stakeholders therein (place-based approach).
- It shall engage the respective stakeholders in design, implementation and delivery stages as well as in the policy uptake of the outputs (stakeholder involvement).

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Other “on demand” evidence production

On-demand evidence production

On-demand territorial study

- // at least one study per country, upon request of the respective MC member;
- // indicative time length: 6 - 12 months;
- // smaller budget and quicker procurement;
- // blending the national/regional policy context, the country's research competence and a European perspective;
- // fitting the specific TAP
- // can target all territorial levels and / or involve national/regional/local stakeholders.

In-house studies

- // initiated bottom-up by any stakeholder
- // indicative time length: 3 - 6 months;
- // delivered by ESPON EGTC;
- // fitting the specific TAP;
- // resulting in a policy brief; position/ reflection paper (a paper with cross-cutting policy observations); or a country fiche (a paper compiling country-specific information from various ESPON research projects).

On-demand evidence production

Policy and Programme analyses

- // can be national or transnational;
- // address the national policy context and bring in the European territorial evidence as an input for analysis;
- // may test/apply findings of a specific European research project or targeted analysis in another territory;
- // fitting the specific TAP
- // are initiated bottom up, via direct dialogue with the MC members.

Data Acquisition / Updates

- // meant to provide ready-to-use sets of harmonised and updated indicators on the development of the European territory;
- // fitting the specific TAP;
- // are initiated either by ESPON EGTC or stakeholders.

// transnational knowledge development activities by the EGTC

Policy events

// initiated by the EGTC or on request of MC, ECPs or groups of stakeholders

// aimed to boost the uptake of the produced territorial evidence.

// include such formats as: conferences, thematic seminars, peer learning workshops, policy labs or ad-hoc policy impact evaluation events

Learning events

// initiated by the EGTC or on request or groups of ECPs or stakeholders

// offer different formats of training sessions

// meant to increase the stakeholders' fluency in using the ESPON EGTC web applications, mapping solutions, policy analysis tools or specific methodologies

Networking events


// initiated by the EGTC or on request of ECP or groups of researchers or stakeholders

// meant to facilitate information exchange between stakeholders, researchers and practitioners

// include such formats as: territorial observatory events, scientific conferences or topical exchange sessions




Targeted Analyses - proposals **selected** (total after 1st, 2nd and 3rd cut-off dates)
