The European Commission's <u>European Solidarity Corps</u> promotes both voluntary projects in Europe and professional mobility projects (work experience, traineeship or apprenticeship).

The Italian project is part of the area of professional mobility and is funded by the <u>Community programma EaSi</u> (European Programme for Employment and Social Innovation) 2014 - 2020.

ANPAL for European Solidarity Corps **offers 2,000 young jobseekers** the opportunity to work or receive a paid traineeship of between 2 and 12 months in one of the 28 EU Member States.

The project lasts 29 months: it was launched on 2 May 2017 and will end on 30 September 2019.

Those who can participate in the project are:

•public and private enterprises and bodies in the third sector offering employment or traineeship opportunities.
