



Connecting Europe Facility-objectives


- remove bottlenecks, enhance rail interoperability, bridge missing links and, in particular, improve cross-border sections
- ensure sustainable and efficient transport systems - decarbonisation through transition to innovative low-carbon and energy-efficient transport technologies, while optimising safety.
- optimise the integration and interconnection of transport modes and enhance the interoperability of transport services, while ensuring the accessibility of transport infrastructures.

TEN-T Network: Dual layer network structure

- *The comprehensive network*: A 'broader' network to be completed by 2050
- *The core network*: The parts of the comprehensive network which are of the highest strategic importance to be completed by 2030 with enhanced parameters, e.g. availability of alternative fuels
- *The core network corridors*: The core network corridors cover the most important long-distance flows in the core network with a view to improve the cross-border links in particular



CEF funding per Corridor and Mode


CEF Funding per Corridor and Mode (€ billion)




CEF in Italy (Transport grants 2014-2020)

Italian beneficiaries participated in 101 projects and received EUR 1.68 billion in CEF Transport co-funding with investment of these projects of EUR 4.5 billion.

Additionally 7 projects take place in Italy, but without the involvement of Italian beneficiaries. These projects correspond to a total of EUR 76,3 million of CEF Transport funding for a total investment of EUR 355,4 million
